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SPARKLING WINE (125ml glass / bottle)

1. PROSECCO, CASTELLA SPUMANTE, ITALY

The height of fashion. Gentle on the nose & palate, finished with a lemon sherbet hue: £5 / £25.

WHITE (175ml glass / bottle)

2. PINOT GRIGIO, MININI, VENETO, ITALY

Very delicate & elegant. Dry, uplifting & aromatic with a hint of lemon: £4.75 / £19.

3. SAUVIGNON BLANC, DOMAINE GRAUZAN, FRANCE

A crisp & herbaceous Sauvignon Blanc with gooseberry freshness & a broad palate: £4.25 / £16.50.

4. RIESLING CHARDONNAY, ASTOR, PFALZ, GERMANY

For those who prefer a touch of sweetness, dominated by racy-scented Riesling: £4 / £15.50.

5. MONTEPULCIANO DABRUZZO, MININI, ITALY

Delicious Morello cherries, hint of spice and enticing youthful charm: £4.25 / £17.

6. ENTORNO TEMPRANILLO, SPAIN

Juicy blackberry fruit, soft, rounded & very easy drinking: £3.50 / £13.50.

7. MERLOT, FINCA EL PICADOR, VALLE CENTRAL, CHILE

Lush & almost warm Merlot fruit. Bordeaux elegance with New World concentration: £4 / £15.50.

8. PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ, CARLO DAMIANI, ITALY

Showing great elegance, pale pink in colour with perfect acidity & restraint: £5 / £19.50.

9. GRENACHE ROSÉ, LA VIGNETTE, VIN DE PAYS DE LAUDE, FRANCE

Rose petal & light strawberry fruit, deliciously crisp & delicate: £4 / £15.50.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING (by the bottle)

10. CHAMPAGNE, BEAUMONT DES CRAYÈRES GRANDE RÉSERVE BRUT NV, FRANCE

Old-fashioned & extremely elegant with yeasty-biscuity notes & a soft & gentle mousse: ½ bottle £26.50 / £40.

11. PROSECCO, VALDOBBIADENE BRUT, JEIO BISOL, ITALY

Light, uplifting & deliciously refreshing with soft delicate bubbles & a lemon tang: £32.

12. CAVA, CASTELL DOLÈRDOLA BRUT ROSADO, SPAIN

Delicious summer fruit aromas & flavours, strawberries & raspberries. Delicate, floral & dry: £24.

13. CÔTES DE PROVENCE ROSÉ, DOMAINE HOUCART, PROVENCE, FRANCE

Beautiful on the nose, with strawberry fruit notes & uplifting & enchanting acidity: £22.

14. TWO MOORS ROSÉ, EASTCOTT VINEYARD, OKEHAMPTON, DEVON

Delicious local wine with gentle redcurrant & strawberry notes, medium dry: £21.50.

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WHITES (by the bottle)

European

15. GRILLO, PALMA NERA, SICILY

Clean, herbaceous & slightly peppery notes with elegance & restraint: £16.50.

16. TRIADE BIANCO, FIANO FALANGHINA GRECO, CAMPANIA, ITALY

An outstanding Italian White. Instantly appealing honeysuckle, pear drops & herbaceous notes: £21.

17. PICPOUL DE PINET, DOMAINE DES LAURIERS, FRANCE

Edging towards off-dry with honey-lemon notes, surprisingly rich in texture yet clean & lingering: £18.50.

18. DART VALLEY RESERVE, SHARPHAM VINEYARD, TOTNES

Deliciously fragrant & uplifting on both the bouquet & palate, yet not too weighty. Off dry: £24.50.

19. MACON PRISSÉ, LES CLOCHETTES, BURGUNDY, FRANCE

Uncomplicated & un-wooded, delivering tight clean fruit with a touch of minerality. Fabulous! £25.

20. SAUVIGNON BLANC, LE FUMÉ BLANC, FRANÇOIS LURTON, FRANCE

Punchy & immensely fruity wine with great finish & length: £22.50.

21. SIEGEL MOSEL RIESLING, MOSEL, GERMANY

Perfect balance between scented, slightly spicy fruit & natural acidity, not too dry: £19.

Non-European

22. CHARDONNAY-SEMILLON, CASA SILVA, COLCHAGUA VALLEY, CHILE

Gentle, tropical fruit, melon & a kiss of butter: £19.

23. SAUVIGNON BLANC, FAIRFIELDS, MARLBOROUGH, NZ

Gooseberry, asparagus, lime, green pepper, so very New Zealand in style: £18.50.

24. CHENIN BLANC, THE WINERY OF GOOD HOPE, STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA

Voted best South African Chenin, crunchy green apples, dry honey & pear drops: £20.

25. VIOGNIER, LAS MANITOS, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

A true to style Viognier. Peach-apricot & lively & rich texture: £16.50.

REDS (by the bottle)

European

26. CHIANTI, VILLA MARNIA, TUSCANY, ITALY

Tuscany in a bottle! Morello cherry & damson with a welcome Mediterranean bite: £19.50.

27. PRIMITIVO PASSITIVO, PUGLIA, ITALY

Upfront dried fruit & plummy Red climaxing with a lingering glow, a must with game: £21.

28. SALICE SALENTINO ROSSO RISERVA, PAOLO LEO, PUGLIA, ITALY

Predominantly Negroamaro. Dried dark fruit with bitter-sweet nuances. Ideal with dark meats: £25.50.

29. CHÂTEAU LA ROCA, CÔTES DU ROUSSILLON, FRANCE

Hedgerow fruit enhanced by a touch of spice & gentle oak: £19.

30. FLEURIE, LUCIEN LARDY, BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE

Aromas of soft red cherry & raspberry with layers of red plum, strawberry & nutmeg flavours: £34.

31. RIOJA, MONTELCIEGO CVC, SPAIN

Very much traditional Rioja style with well-rounded plummy fruit enhanced by smoky oak: £18.50.

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Non-European

32. CABERNET-MERLOT, CASA SILVA, COLCHAGUA VALLEY, CHILE

This wine displays exaggerated berry fruit notes with very Bordelaise overtones: £19.

33. MALBEC, CRISTOBAL 1492, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

A deliberately vibrant, complex Red displaying a touch of eucalyptus & fig: £21.50.

34. FINCHER SHIRAZ, MCLAREN VALE, AUSTRALIA

Well-rounded & rich dried fruit notes. Soft on the palate with a hint of spice & bramble: £20.

35. PINOT NOIR, OMRAH, PLANTAGENET, AUSTRALIA

Aromas of cherry and raspberry on the nose with distinctive spice & subtle undertones of oak: £29.

PUDDING WINE

36. MUSCAT DE RIVESALTES, DOM BRIAL, FRANCE

Rich, honey-melon & Seville orange, yet not too sticky – great acidity: 50ml glass £4.00 / bottle £24.

37. BOTRYTIS RIESLING, TAMAR RIDGE, TASMANIA

Bursting with passion fruit & tropical fruit flavours, sweet, yet citrus on the finish: 50ml glass £5.50 / bottle £35
